**Do not refer patients to these CBACs after 3:30pm on Friday 31 July.**

- NORTH: AUT North Campus, Northcote
- CENTRAL: Eden Terrace Community Testing Centre, Grafton
- WEST: Whanau House, Waipareira Trust, Henderson
- SOUTH: The Whānau Ora Community Clinic, Wiri

All CTCs will open this weekend only. After this weekend, they will open Monday to Friday and be closed over the weekends.

People needing a COVID-19 test outside the Community Testing Centre (CTC) opening hours will need to go to a general practice or urgent care clinic.

### PRIORITY GROUPS

You should offer tests to anyone who has any COVID-19 symptoms.

Please also test anyone who requests a test because they are concerned about the traveller from New Zealand who recently tested positive for COVID-19 in South Korea.

### TESTING FOR AIR NEW ZEALAND CREW

There are now increased requirements for Air New Zealand crew to be tested, including testing for pre-flight clearance to Hong Kong.

Crew will be provided with surveillance testing vouchers and may present to CTCs, general practice, or urgent care clinics for testing. Please test them and record the surveillance (SURV) code on the lab form and claim for this testing via the usual e-notification form to POAC.

#### Pneumovax 23

There are limited stocks of pneumovax 23 available for use with a further shipment expected to arrive in late August. Please limit or delay administration of Pneumovax 23 where possible until further stock is available.
