#### New SURV codes for border-related COVID-19 Case – TM16

On Thursday 8th April, a border-related case of COVID-19 was identified in a worker at the Grand Millennium managed isolation facility.

#### Covid-19 Vaccination: Update for Primary Care

Inviting primary care health workers to get their COVID-19 vaccination is a top priority for the Covid vaccination programme. Thousands of invitations have already been sent to primary care staff over the last few weeks, with additional invitations planned next week. There has been excellent uptake from the sector. We have heard some of you have experienced frustrations with the booking system, and we apologise for that. The NRHCC is working hard to refine the system and process. If you are concerned that your invitation is delayed please call the vaccination helpline on 0800 28 29 26.

Vaccinations are taking place at a number of community vaccination centres now open across Auckland.

Currently open:

- Auckland CBD Vaccination Centre (21 Elliot St, Auckland)
- Highbrook Vaccination Centre (31 Highbrook Drive East Tamaki)
- Otara Vaccination Centre (5 Otara Road)
- Manuwera Vaccination Centre (Manuwera Marae, 81 Finlayson Ave, Clendon Park)



Open this week:

- Waitakere Vaccination Centre (Snelgar Building, Waitakere Hospital, 55 Lincoln Road)
- Mt Wellington Vaccination Centre (95-101 Leonard Road)

The NRHCC is working hard to secure sites to ensure broader coverage across the metro-Auckland area.

As part of this process, an initial tranche of primary care providers has been selected through an EOI process, to create additional access points across the metro-Auckland area. We are hoping to add to this network over the following months.
