Foot Screening and Management in Diabetes

A full review with input from the region's podiatrists, vascular surgeons and diabetologists. All patients with acutely infected feet should be referred to vascular surgery - this is a change from previous processes.

See the <u>Acute Vascular Surgery Assessment</u> pathway for the process in your DHB. Note that POAC does not fund intravenous antibiotics for foot infections (including cellulitis) in patients with diabetes unless endorsed by a relevant specialist.

Haematuria in Children and Proteinuria in Children

Two pathways that deal with relatively common findings in children, that often give rise to uncertainty regarding investigation and management. The pathways describe when there is cause for concern and lead clinicians through the various combinations of presentations. The pathways also include detailed information on determining whether blood pressure readings in children are high.
