Registered nurses practising in community health settings e.g. high school nurses, public health nurses, primary health nurses can complete a work-based education programme and then apply to Nursing Council for prescribing authority for a limited number of medicines for minor ailments and illnesses in normally healthy people without significant health problems, <https://www.nursingcouncil.org.nz/>

This is a six month blended learning programme, commencing with two face to face study days

Registered Nurses must be qualified for 3 years and have been in their present place of employment for minimum 1 year
